

Installation Instructions for FUZE Over Dry---Erase Marker Board

- 1. Tape off the frame and all other areas not intended to be painted with low adhesion masking tape.
- 2. Scuff marker board surface.
 - √ Use medium grit sandpaper (100 ---120 grit)
- 3. Dry Wipe surface with a clean cloth to remove dust from sanding.
- 4. Prime surface with Glidden Gripper, Kilz Premium, or Sherwin---Williams Multi---Purpose Primer.
 - √ Use 3/16" nap roller
 - It is important to "over---roll" the primer application to insure that it achieves a full bond everywhere; apply the primer generously, level it out, back roll, and then rebalance for complete coverage
 - √ Allow primer to dry for a minimum of 90 --- 120 minutes, 4 hours preferred.
- 5. Sand smooth (lightly) the primed surface.
 - √ Use fine grit sandpaper (180 grit)
- 6. Dry Wipe surface with a clean cloth to remove dust from sanding.
- 7. Apply FUZE according to installation instructions included in each kit.
