

PVC-Free Wallcovering

Stains should be removed as soon as possible to eliminate any possible reaction between the staining agent and the wallcovering. Time is especially important for removing materials containing colors or solvents, such as ballpoint ink, lipstick, oil, shampoo tints and some foodstuffs. If soil remains on the wallcovering too long, permanent discoloration may develop.

Ordinary dirt spots can be removed with a mild soap, warm water, and a natural sea sponge. Clean from the bottom of the wall upward to protect the baseboard and prevent streaking. Rinse thoroughly with clean water from the top down using a sponge. Deeply embossed wallcoverings need extra attention in the event that suds or loosened dirt lodges in depressed surfaces. Blot wallcovering dry with a soft, lint-free towel.

Not recommended for cleaning wallcovering are steel wool or powdered abrasive cleaners because they mar the surface, leaving an unsightly appearance. Do not use active solvent-type cleaning preparations, such as nail polish remover, tar and bug removers, etc., because they will remove print and/or finish from the wallcovering.

When disinfecting please wear appropriate hand and eye protection to cover exposed skin. Proper ventilation must be taken during and after application. Never mix bleach with ammonia any other cleaner. Carefully check all labels for application instructions and expiration dates. For concentrates, ensure that the correct proportion of disinfectant is added to the correct volume of water. Mix the required amount of disinfectant solution in accordance with label instructions. Use the solution immediately after it has been prepared for maximum effectiveness.

Apply disinfectant to the face of the wallcovering starting at the top of the wall. Carefully follow the manufacturer's application instructions. After application dwell time, rinse the disinfected area with water. Allow surfaces to thoroughly air dry before utilizing the area.

The following disinfectants are approved for use on Nvolve wallcoverings:

10% bleach / 90% water solution

60-70% isopropyl alcohol

4.5% hydrogen peroxide

Virex® II 256 quaternary disinfectant cleaner

Sanitizing Rinse SR-22 Concentrate

Spartan DMQ® neutral disinfectant
